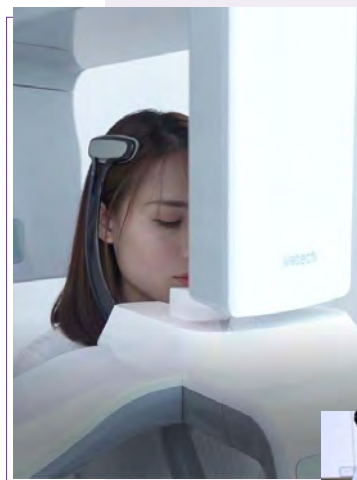
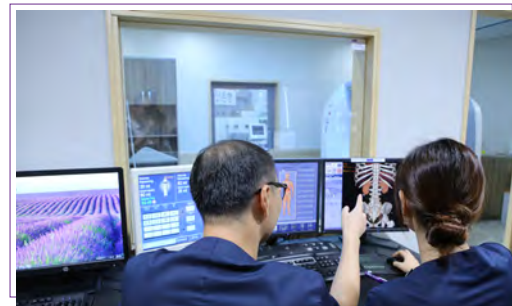

Within 10 minutes from the bustling downtown, there is a grassy park where you can take a leisurely walk and enjoy a phytoncide shower among the cypress trees.



Busan Children's Grand Park Seongjigok Reservoir

Located at the foot of Baekyangsan Mountain is a park in the heart of the city embraced by lush trees such as cedars and cypresses, as well as the Seongjigok Reservoir built in 1907. Surrounding the reservoir, you can find a waterfront park, walking trail, forest bathing area, and Busan Children's Center. The cypress forest, which won the Coexistence Award at the “National Beautiful Forest Contest,” is a must-visit walking course. A forest experience program is also in operation.



As you walk in the green space breathing in the refreshing air, you will feel your heavy steps become lighter and lighter.





Busan Citizens Park

This site was used as a racetrack during the Japanese colonial period, a prisoner-of-war camp during the Korean War, and later became a base for the U.S. Army Hayaria Corps. It was returned to the citizens of Busan in 2014 and became a city park with an area of 473,279 m², where people come to rest and relax.

5 TRADITIONAL WELLNESS



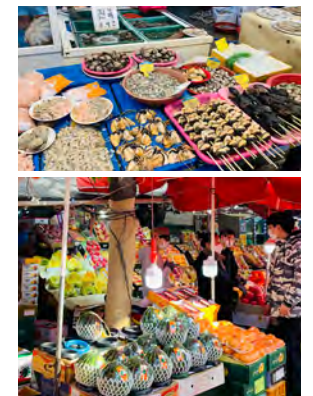
Travel is about delving into the history and culture of a country or city. A place that is the driving force of life and enlightenment for both residents and tourists. Traditional markets, where you meet the locals and experience their culture. Here, you can hear the energetic people of Busan shouting “Oiso, Boiso, Saiso (Come, look, buy)!”



Bujeon Market Town

The largest traditional market in Busan that combines seven major markets including Bujeon Market, Bujeon Ginseng Market, Busan Electronics Market, Seomyeon Market, Bujeon Shopping Mall, Busan early morning market for wholesale agricultural and fishery products, Gijang alley market, etc. was formed during the Korean War, and it presently includes around 3,000 shops. In particular, Bujeon Ginseng Market is the largest in Busan and Gyeongsangnam-do Province, making it a site to visit for domestic and foreign tourists aiming to purchase ginseng products.

Bujeon Ginseng Market

Since its opening in 1989, it has been the largest-scale wholesale market specializing in ginseng in Busan and Gyeongsangnam-do Province, selling products wholesale such as red ginseng (steamed and dried ginseng), fresh (raw) ginseng, white ginseng (peeled and sun-dried ginseng) as well as other health foods. Products can be purchased at a discount for up to 20-50% cheaper than the market price. Here, even the smell of ginseng that fills the mall is healthy.

Ginseng Tip

Q. How can I choose good ginseng?

Ginseng that has three balanced parts with an evenly developed head, trunk, and roots is a good one.

Q. Why is red ginseng good for you?

As toxins are removed during the steaming process, anyone can consume red ginseng without worries. It is effective for improving the immune system, recovering from fatigue, relieving stress, improving your memory, enhancing your blood sugar, and preventing high blood pressure.

Q. Why is 6-year-old ginseng better?

The medicinal effects of ginseng become complete in four to six years; after six years, the root becomes hard, and its medicinal properties decrease.

Q. How can I choose a reliable ginseng product?

Check the inspection certificate, which is based on certificate proving authentic cultivation.

Q. How can I consume ginseng and red ginseng easily, or turn them into a powder?

At Bujeon Ginseng Market, the sellers will ground the ginseng into a powder for free. You can also purchase products that have been processed into healthy and functional foods.

Ginseng

Koreans consume ginseng, or red ginseng, to maintain their health during the changing seasons and at times when the body can easily lose its balance. Ginseng strengthens the immune system, relieves fatigue, enhances your memory, improves blood circulation and acts as an antioxidant. Ginseng has been beloved for thousands of years, and "Dongui Bogam" describes the properties of ginseng as follows:

"It is slightly warm in nature, has a sweet taste, and is not poisonous. It is also called Shincho (神草) and is more effective if it has the shape of a human body." "Ginseng compensates for a lack of energy in the five organs. It is good to eat ginseng in large quantities. It heals those who have become very thin and weak."



Seomyeon Traditional Market

This is a market located at the heart of Seomyeon, which boasts a 100-year history, with two floors above ground that house 190 stores. It is well loved for its food alley with Dwaengi-gukbab, Kal-guksu, Whole chickens, and Tteokbokki, while both old and new style fortune telling boutiques and Saju Cafes add to the fun of experiencing Korean culture.

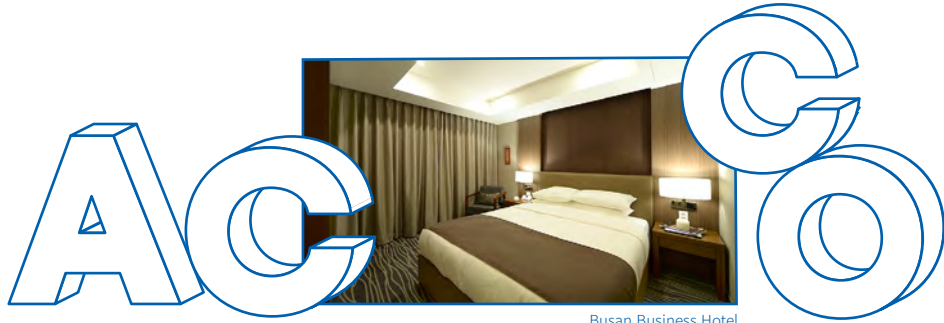

Enjoy Busan's unique soul food that is both tasty and healthy.



Gomjangeo Alley

A healthy food that is rich in collagen and high in protein! Are you curious about sea eels? Then visit this local food street where live sea eels are prepared and cooked on the spot.

The scent of roasting briquettes from the sea eel street near Bujeon Station makes passersby stop in their tracks. The eels are cooked in various ways that include seasoning, grilling, salt-grilling, and barbecuing as a whole piece, but the texture of this attractive dish is always chewy.



Natan(Healthy Food)

Healthy Korean cuisine is served without any addition of chemical seasonings, which preserves the original taste and colors of the ingredients. A variety of dishes can be customized for vegetarians, for halal diets, or for those who are allergic to certain foods.

Everything is served as a multi-course meal, as Basic Full Course, Beautiful Na (beautiful me) Full Course, Generous Tan Full Course, Special Course, Yongbongtang (carp & chicken soup), etc., and reservations are essential. Well-being tea and traditional meditation music are always available, which doubles the enjoyment of dining here.

Busan's soul food

Pork and Rice Soup

This is a representative dish of Busan with added pork and vegetables, along with various seasonings and pickled shrimp, to a broth made from pork bones.

Dwaeji-gukbap embodies the history of Busan, a city of refugees during the Korean War. It is the ultimate dish that was created at a time when people had to fill their stomachs with cheap animal protein and supplement their nutritional needs. The soup has become a must-try soul food for visitors to Busan. Also, we recommend trying the soup with its soul mate, sundae.



Fishcake



The place where you can find the most delicious fish cakes is in Busan, which is overflowing with fresh fish and seafood. Busan's fish cakes are famous for their savory and chewy texture, as well as their high fish content, which has garnered them so much popularity that they are delivered to homes across the nation every day by courier. Among them, Goraesa, a premium fish cake shop also located in department stores, is also found in Bujeon Market.

Freshly prepared warm fish cakes can be enjoyed as snacks, side dishes with drinks, and delicious meals that can be prepared with simple cooking.



Tteokbokki

Tteokbokki is a national snack that every Korean has enjoyed since childhood in front of schools, at homes, and at the markets they visited with their mothers.

It is a dish traditionally cooked by boiling rice cake bars in sweet and spicy gochujang seasoning; nowadays, tteokbokki with creamy sauce and rose tteokbokki (with gochujang and cream sauce) are also popular. Adding various toppings such as fish cakes, ramyeon, and cheese makes the dish even more delicious.

As factory complexes were built in Danggam-dong and Jeonpo-dong area in Busanjin-gu during the era of industrialization in the 1960s, workers came to Seomyeon after work to enjoy a quick bite, and many diners selling tteokbokki were created. How will you remember the taste of tteokbokki, which is omnipresent in the memories of Korean people?



Wheat noodles

If Pyongyang is famous for naengmyeon, Busan is known for milmyeon. This is a noodle dish made by adding wheat flour noodles to cold broth, or by mixing them with various seasonings.

The refugees who came to Busan during the Korean War wanted to eat naengmyeon, but it was difficult to find buckwheat, its core ingredient. Therefore, they replaced it with wheat flour. Milmyeon, which started as an item served in small shops run by refugees, gained popularity throughout Busan, and it has now become one of the city's representative local foods.
